**DUDLEY PARK ROAD/WARWICK ROAD JUNCTION IMPROVEMENT, ACOCKS

Birmingham City Council is committed to ensuring that our highway network operates efficiently and that congestion levels are managed.

At the Ward Committee meeting in November 2008 a number of options were presented and it was agreed that the Committee would support a proposal which removed the bus lane, but retained the zebra crossing and the bus stop.

The supported proposal has been developed and is shown in the attached plan CA-01408-01-2-017 Rev A which comprises of:

- Removal of the bus Lane on Dudley Park Road and Warwick Road.
- Removal of a central refuge at the zebra crossing on Warwick Road
- Proposed build-out at the zebra crossing to enhance pedestrian safety
- New signs and road markings.

Your local knowledge is valued and we would be grateful if you could advise us within the next 2 weeks of your views on the above proposal. A questionnaire and prepaid envelope is attached with this letter for your response.
